

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT IN ENGINEERING or GEOSCIENCE

1. PURPOSE

Lifetime Achievement in Engineering or Geoscience

The award recognizes an individual who has demonstrated exceptional and sustained contributions over a minimum of 30 years in the practice of engineering or geoscience profession. This award honors individuals whose professional excellence, leadership through service, and community involvement have produced a lasting impact on the profession and on society, and whose career represents a model of integrity, commitment, and achievement.

2. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for nomination, a candidate must:

1. Have a **minimum of 30 years of professional experience** in engineering or geoscience;
2. Have demonstrated sustained contributions to the profession and/or society;
3. Eligible regardless of current employment status (including retired professionals);
4. Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba membership (**past or present**) essential. India Chapter membership is desirable.

Maximum 300 words

Describe the nominee's **voluntary involvement with Professional societies and leadership** in:

- Professional or technical organizations;
- Committees, boards, mentoring, education, standards development, or advocacy.

Explain the **impact of this service** on the profession, its members, or public understanding of engineering/geoscience.

Question 3 — Community Involvement & Societal Impact (25%)

Maximum 300 words

Describe the nominee's **community involvement outside formal professional work**, including volunteerism, outreach, public service, or leadership.

Explain how these activities have resulted in **meaningful and lasting benefits** to the community or society.
